**SOME VERY GOOD NEWS ABOUT MONEY** – Because of the generosity of many people and some astute financial management we met all our expenses in full last year – including our Parish Share payment of £61000. Well done everybody, and thank you very much indeed.

**MONDAY CHURCH** – Dan Tansey started Monday Church in a low-key way before Christmas but now this new service is being launched more publicly. Monday Church is for adults who want to go to an informal day-time church service offered as an alternative to Sundays. Monday Church is a relaxed and friendly gathering where we begin by sitting around and chatting then go on to some teaching from the bible, followed by prayer and worship, all led by a member of the clergy team. Monday church takes place from 11am to about 12:30pm at All Saint's church in North Wootton.

**SING ON TUESDAY** – On Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> February we will be starting a brand new Woottons Community Choir. It will be held at South Wootton Junior School every Tuesday during term time from 7-9.00pm. We are offering two free taster sessions initially (20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> February) and then from Tuesday 6thh March we will charge £3 per person for each evening – this will cover the cost of using the school, music, and refreshments. Barbara Backham, Jemma McRae and David Hill will lead the choir and provide musical accompaniment. No experience needed, and no auditions will required to join the choir – everyone will be welcome. Please tell your family, your friends and come along with them!

**WEDNESDAY CHURCH** - Wednesday Church used to be called "Mid Week Church" and it used to take place on Tuesdays.... Wednesday Church is our evening based mid-week service. It has an emphasis on sung worship and extended teaching. We aim for a relaxed atmosphere in which to worship, learn and pray. Wednesday Church takes place at the Rectory, it begins at 7.30pm, ends by about 9.00pm with a cuppa for those who want it.

**THURSDAY DROP IN** - Our Drop-In runs from 8.45-12.00 each Thursday morning at St Mary's Church. The church is warm, there are tables to sit around, quizzes to do, games to play and toys for very young children to play with. We serve tea, coffee, squash, and delicious home baking. Never been to the Drop-In? Why not give it a go?
