ANNUAL PAROCHIAL CHURCH MEETING – Our Annual Meeting will be held on the morning of Sunday 22nd April at South Wootton Village Hall to be followed by a shared lunch. The morning will include a service of Holy Communion held in the Village Hall. The services that would have been held at All Saints Church on that day will be transferred to 29th April. Churchwardens, PCC members, and sidespeople are all elected at the APCM and various annual reports are given. This is a very important and encouraging date in the Church's year – please put the date in your diary.

MAUNDY THURSDAY – Your clergy will attending the Chrism Eucharist at Norwich Cathedral on Maundy Thursday and invite you to join them at this very special service when they renew their ordination vows. JAMES HAWKSWORTH- As you Know, Kings Lynn is full of secondary school age young people. As I go and visit various different churches, projects and schools the common feeling is that our young people don't have many places to go where they can let their hair down in a safe environment and that they lack aspiration. As a Church Army Evangelist working across the deanery of Lynn in partnership with the local churches, I want this to change. Part of my work is to raise awareness of missional needs in the area and to find support in prayer and financial giving to support this venture.
