CHRISTMAS IS A COMIN' – Christmas is the busiest and most demanding time of year for us in the Church in the Woottons. Over Christmas we will be putting on 8 special services in addition to our usual Sunday programme. We expect many of these services to be very well attended and busy in every way! GIFT DAY – Our annual Gift Day will be held on Saturday 17th November 9.00am – 5.00pm. The costs of running The Church in the Woottons increase each year but we are currently experiencing a decline in income. Our fee income is lower this year because we have conducted fewer weddings and funerals than we usually do, and our regular giving is down a little too. We are very grateful to all of you who give regularly through the envelope scheme or by direct debit – you can start giving in either of these ways at any time. The Gift Day is the perfect opportunity for those of you who don't feel able to give regularly to make a contribution to the financial running of the Church. It costs nearly £100000 annually to offer the ministry we do through The Church in the Woottons and we are facing a significant shortfall this year. Please help if you can. You can bring your cash or a cheque to the Rectory on the 17th November, or drop it in or send it by post any time before or soon after the 17th. Many thanks.
