Proceeds from the Harvest Supper shared between Christian Aid (50%) and our two current building projects (50%). APPEAL LAUNCH - IMPROVE ST MARY'S CHURCH BALCONY - We think it will cost less than £8000 to complete this project and **we now have nearly £3000 allocated to it.** We hope the work will be completed early next year and so we are launching an appeal for the funds and we will be applying for grant aid too.
