Christingle Services 2021

I am very pleased to announce that we are holding live Christingle Services this year. However, because of the current situation regarding COVID 19 and high infection levels, we have made some significant changes:

- 1. We will be offering 4 Christingle Services this year 2 services at each church
- 2. None of the Christingle Services will take place on Christmas Eve this year. Instead, we will run them on the evenings of four schooldays leading up to the end of term each service will begin at 6.00pm
- 3. Because our church buildings are relatively small, we are placing a limit on the number of people (adults and children) who can attend each service.
- 4. At St. Mary's Church, South Wootton, we are limiting the number of people (adults and children) who can attend each Christingle Service to 75
- 5. At All Saints Church, North Wootton, we are limiting the number of people (adults and children) who can attend each Christingle Service to 70.
- 6. Because we are having to restrict numbers who can attend our Christingle Services this year we wish to give priority to families with young children. Of course, grandparents will be welcome to come as part of a family.
- 7. We ask that you email james@churchinthewoottons.net to reserve your places. Please tell James who will be attending and the ages of your children. We will then issue you with a family ticket.
